a few words about the artists:

LAND OF THE LOOPS is a smooth sampledelic adventure into the mind of beat juggling, mix-making, experimental musician and art teacher Alan Sutherland, who turned to quirky electronica after he conned his parents to buy him a sampler for college graduation. The Boston via-Brooklyn sonic collagist thrives on goofy samples placed over hypnotic, sci-fi beats and tweaked bass hooks, all of which spiral drunkenly into the brain creating a fresh breath of analogue air into the digital sea that now calls itself electronica. Two albums, two eps and his music having been featured in 2 episodes of "The Sopranos" and on Sofia Coppola's 1998 short "Lick The Star", Land Of the Loops comes back after 4 years of silence with this brand new split ep containing "Sippy Cup" (bollywood-flavoured super-catchy single), "Tippy Cup" (remixed by Asphodel records' lounge-collage duo *Tipsy* from San Francisco) and two interludes (hidden tracks on the cd version and ending with a lockgroove on the vinyl version).

Dave Fuller is the man behind the **BUCKMINSTER FUZEBOARD** boards. Already a collaborator of Land Of The Loops and one of the gurus of the casiocore movement, Dave lives in Boulder, Colorado (but spends quite sometime in Dublin, Ireland too). These two new tracks "Chest Expander" and "3 Frogs" are a delicious appetizer of what will be his long-awaited second lp due out on Unhip records. His sedate beats to sleep away an afternoon to and the solid combination of head-nodding groove, beat and a taste for unexpected arrangements and weirdly haunting touches are still the main elements that make him the king of "unhip-hop".

To wrap up this split ep is Dave's anti-war bit "Street Of '91". Vinyl limited to 500 copies.
